In May of 2015, the town of Pinetops received a request from the Katie B. Reynolds Health Care Trust to apply for a grant to fund a park for the town. That summer, with Vines' leadership and enthusiasm, 200 citizens came together to make the park a reality. The park will be dedicated to Vines' memory. Vines served this church in many different capacities during his lifetime. He was a local banker for 34 years and served as an elected official in Pinetops and Edgecombe County for 50 years.

A "Blessing of the Garden" will be held at the Pinetops Community Garden Sunday, June 11th at 9:00 am. We will give thanks for the work which has been done and for the work yet to do. Please join in the blessing of this project which binds us together as a community of faith.

Edgecombe Community College will offer classes focusing on cooking garden-fresh vegetables. Mr. Joe White, chef and caterer of Myrtle Grove Catering will be the instructor. Classes will be held Tuesdays June 20, July 25, and August 15 from 6-8 pm at Pinetops Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall. The cost for all 3 classes is \$70 or \$35 per class.
